

Two Staff Members Test Positive for COVID-19 at The Perley and Rideau Veterans' Health Centre

Tuesday, April 28, 2020 – Ottawa, Ontario (as of 9 am)

Two Perley Rideau staff members have tested positive for COVID-19. This brings to 24 the total number of staff members who have tested positive for the virus. All staff members are sell-isolating at home. We wish each of them a speedy recovery and look forward to their return.

As of 9 am this morning, the number of residents who have tested positive for the virus remains unchanged at 7. They are being cared for on the 20-bed SAFE unit that has been converted to an isolation unit.

To date, four residents testing positive for COVID-19 have passed away. Not all of these deaths have been directly linked to COVID-19.

To better align with public reporting standards, we have adapted the information provided in our regular updates..

Residents

- 604 COVID-19 resident tests

 (all residents have been tested, at least once)
- 11 positive results
- Seven active cases
- Four deaths (not all deaths have been attributed to COVID-19)

Staff

- 965 COVID-19 tests on staff
- 24 positive staff results
- 24 active cases

Testing Update

- To date, 1569 tests on residents and staff have been conducted.
- The Perley Rideau's precautionary swabbing tests account for 1308 tests.
- All Substitute Decision Makers were contacted prior to a resident's first COVID-19 test.
- All Substitute Decision Makers will be contacted when a test result is returned, regardless of whether the result is negative or positive.

The Incident Command Team gathers daily to address this pandemic and new challenges as they arise.
