

Research and Caregiving Engagement Session

International experts present latest research and participate in panel discussion with Ottawa caregivers.

On Thursday, June 29, 2023, a ground-breaking half-day event promises to advance public understanding of the crucial role that non-professional caregivers play in healthcare systems worldwide. During the event, international experts will present the latest research about the health and well-being of non-professional caregivers—typically family members. Following the presentation, the experts will participate alongside non-professional caregivers in a panel discussion about caregivers' needs and the future of care.

The role of non-professional caregivers will become increasingly important due to demographic trends. Canada's population of seniors is expected to triple in the next few decades and threatens to overwhelm current approaches to housing and caring for seniors, particularly those living with frailty. Two of the organizations working to develop appropriate solutions are cohosting this engagement session.

InterRAI is a collaborative international network of researchers and practitioners determined to improve the care of people with medically complex needs. The network develops and promotes evidence-informed tools for clinical practice and policymaking.
