

## Three Staff Members Test Positive for COVID-19 at The Perley and Rideau Veterans' Health Centre

May 3, 2020 - Ottawa, Ontario (as of 9 am)

In the past 24 hours, three staff members have tested positive for COVID-19. Since the start of the pandemic, 33 staff members have contracted the virus.

The three staff members include two PSWs from Gatineau 2 South and an Allied Health staff member working on Ottawa 2 East.

All staff members testing positive for the virus are self-isolating at home. The entire Perley Rideau community is rallying behind our team. We wish everyone a speedy and full recovery.

In the past 24 hours, no resident has tested positive for COVID-19. Since the start of the pandemic, 20 residents have contracted the virus and six residents have passed away. Not all of the deaths have been attributed to COVID-19. There are 14 residents being cared for on the isolation unit in the Ottawa building.

As part of a combined aggressive surveillance regime, there have been more than 1670 COVID-19 tests on residents and staff.

Several measures have been taken to protect residents and staff, including:

- 1. Ongoing testing for COVID-19 for residents and staff;
- 2. Mandatory procedural face masks for all staff;
- 3. Contact tracing for all individuals testing positive for the virus;
- 4. Twice-daily active screening of residents and staff;
- 5. Additional housekeeping support;
- 6. Restricted staff movement between buildings and on units;
- 7. Meal helpers have been hired for every unit in the home to support with meals, nourishment passes, and other duties. Each unit has been assigned a team.
- 8. Housekeeping staff have increased cleaning across all home units to 16 hours a day.
- 9. To assist with PSW workload demands, weekly bathing schedules have been adapted to provide first bath/shower of the week, however the second bath/shower will only be completed as needed.

The Command Centre Team is addressing this pandemic, adapting plans and confronting new challenges as they arise.
