Important Service Disruptions

This special newsletter provides an important update on upcoming construction work in the Perley Centre. Please be aware of the following planned service disruptions and potential noise..

Planned Water Shutdown

A temporary water shutdown is scheduled for **Thursday, August 14, 2025, from 7 a.m. to 9 a.m.**

During this time, water will be unavailable in these locations:

- Creative Arts studios
- Second-floor washroom
- Small cleaner's closet in the Perley Centre

Piling Work: Noise and Vibrations

From **Tuesday, August 19 to Friday, September 5, 2025**, crews will be performing piling work (drilling into the ground). This work will likely generate significant noise and vibrations.

We strongly recommend that anyone working in or near the affected area use hearing protection. You can get free hearing protection from the Support Services offices on the second floor of the Perley Centre.

Arts Studio Closure

The art studios on the second floor of the Perley Centre will be closed during the piling work from **Tuesday, August 19 to Friday, September 5, 2025**. Staff will adjust programs accordingly, and community members can find updates on the unit activity calendar whiteboards. We will post a more detailed notice once those program changes are confirmed later this week.
