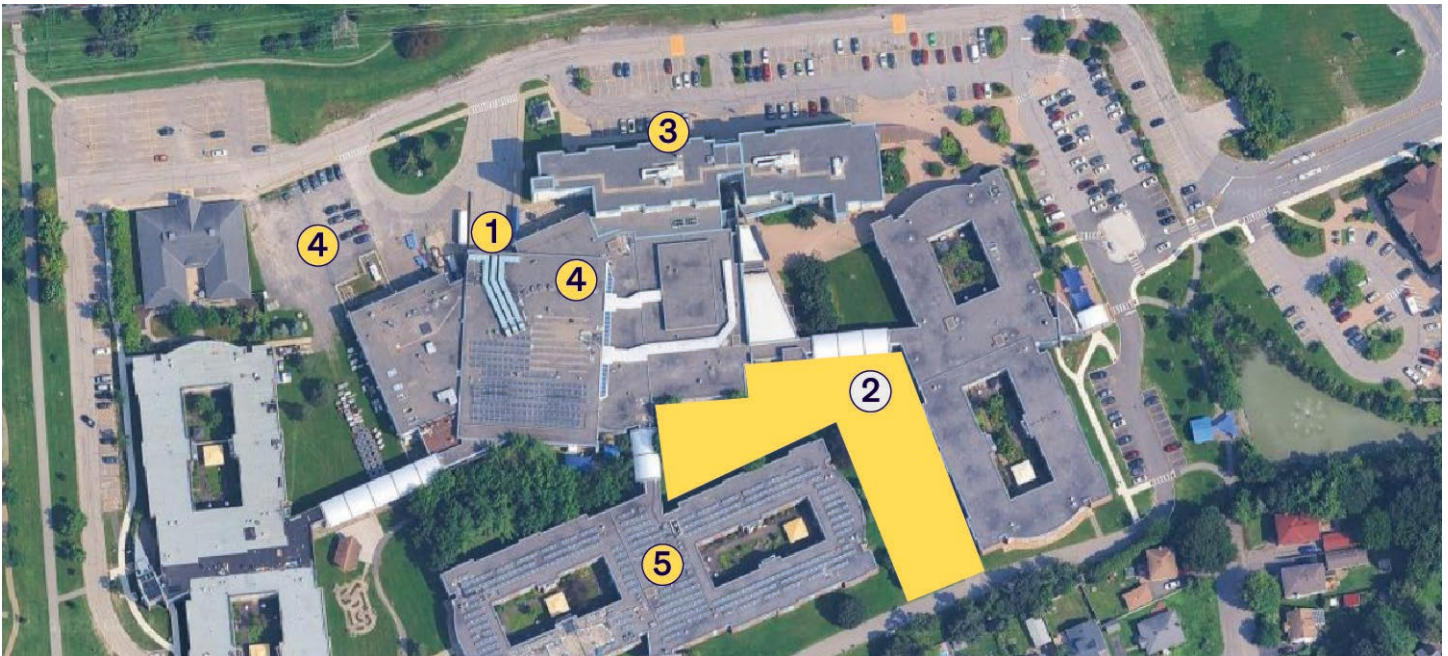

- **Noise:** If you are affected by construction noise, free hearing protection is available from the Support Services offices on the second floor of the Perley Centre.
- **Winter Safety:** Please take extra care outdoors to prevent slips and falls.
 - Use the **provided salt bins** for icy areas.
 - Wear **non-slip footwear**.
 - Walk cautiously using the **"Penguin Shuffle"** technique.
 - Keep your hands free for balance and stay on designated walkways.

Recently Completed Work

1. **Loading Dock Door Repairs:** The repairs to the middle bay of the landing dock are complete.

2. **Intergenerational Child Care:** Construction continues inside Perley Health and in the adjacent courtyard. For specifics, see the update below
3. **Charging Stations:** Installation of four charging stations near the entrance to Commissionaires Ottawa Place is complete. Commissioning is currently underway. The stations are expected to be ready for use by January.
4. **Perley Centre Re-roofing:** Re-roofing work at the Perley Centre is ongoing and will continue as long as weather permits.
 - The staff parking lot next to Respite House remains closed to support construction activities. Please use the other designated staff parking areas.

Construction Progress

- The framing of the walls is finished.
- The installation of the Mechanical and Electrical systems inside the walls is near completion, at 95% complete.
- A mandatory inspection of the work inside the walls is scheduled for the week of December 15th.
 - This ensures all mechanical, electrical, and plumbing components meet safety and building codes before the walls are closed in.
- The installation of the remaining Mechanical and Electrical infrastructure is now focused on the ceiling spaces
