Projects Accomplished

We have successfully completed a wide array of indoor and outdoor improvements. Many of these projects could not have happened without the incredible support of our community and the generous donors to the Perley Health Foundation - whose generosity fuels the Perley Health mission and transforms lives in meaningful, lasting ways.

These projects include:

1. Ottawa Residence re-roofing
2. Andrew Fleck Children's Services Intergenerational Early Learning Centre

3. Sidewalk replacements and repairs outside the Respite House
4. New patio stones installed outside the Rideau Veterans Residence entrance and Commissionaire Ottawa Place
5. Additional parking and a new island patio that includes a seating area
6. Re-installation of the Perley Health map near the entrance gates
7. Electric Vehicle (EV) charging stations outside Commissionaires Ottawa Place, near the Staff Entrance
8. Plumbing Upgrades – hot and cold water mixing valves - in Commissionaires Ottawa Place

Thanks to the generous donors to the Perley Health Foundation for these projects:

- **Pathway to the cenotaph grounds:** Developed an accessible pathway allowing all members of the Perley Health community to safely visit the monument.
- **Sidewalk and ramp repairs:** Restored the pathways in front of the Rideau Veterans Residence, improving safety and accessibility.
- **Outdoor programming space:** Constructed an accessible outdoor programming space in front of the Rideau Veterans Residence, creating an inclusive area for residents, families, and community activities.

Ongoing Projects

1. Perley Centre Re-roofing

The re-roofing of the Perley Centre involves 14 distinct sections. The process follows a six-step progression, beginning with solar panel removal and ending with the installation of metal flashing. Currently, work is underway on 12 sections, with 10 sections nearing completion. This work is expected to conclude in the fall.

- The staff parking lot next to Respite House remains closed to accommodate the roofing crews.

2. Heating, Ventilation and Air Conditioning (HVAC) Enhancements

HVAC improvements continue throughout the campus. Contractors are on site completing the installation of valve actuators in all the mechanical rooms. These enhancements will be tied into the new Building Automation System. We anticipate that this work will be completed by the end of this month (July 2026).
