## Visiting Reminders:

- A limit of 2 visitors at a time per resident on November 11
- When you arrive, clean your hands using hand sanitizer, rubbing thoroughly over all areas of your hands.
- Indoor visitors will be provided a surgical mask. At all times, visitors must wear a mask, covering nose and mouth.
- For everyone's safety, maintain physical distance (2 m/6 ft) and minimize physical contact during your visit.

For residents without access to Facebook, staff will be hosting small physically-distanced gatherings on units. These gatherings are restricted to residents only, in accordance with ministry policy.
