We will share information on a wide range of Perley Health services, including:


- The Active Seniors and Veterans Living Centre

## First Privacy Day at Perley Health

Wednesday, January 28th, marked the successful launch of the first Privacy Day at Perley Health, where topics typically kept private became the talk of the town. Throughout the day, staff and residents engaged in various activities designed to increase awareness of privacy as a vital aspect of life within our community. The privacy team travelled across the facility with a Mobile Education Cart, offering interactive learning opportunities and distributing “thank you” treats to participants.

Staff were encouraged to complete a brief online privacy quiz accessed through either a QR code or email for a chance to win prizes, with an additional bonus entry available for those who answered question cards in person. The event also featured the debut of Privacy Matters, the first privacy newsletter, highlighting key initiatives and themes. To foster a sense of shared community values, the cart displayed resident comments on what privacy meant to them, while staff contributed their own perspectives and voted for their favourite privacy messages.

## Your Voice Matters: The Perley Health Expansion Survey is Now Live!

Perley Health has taken a major step toward significantly increasing the number of people we serve. Earlier this month, Our Board of Directors approved the next phase of planning and design for a new on-site building that will provide long-term care (LTC) for an additional 120 residents.

With over 1,000 people currently on our LTC waitlist and local demand for care expected to rise by 43%, this expansion is vital to meeting the needs of our community.

We are committed to open and transparent communication as we move toward our target occupancy date in late 2028. We want to hear from you to help guide the project's design and development.

The survey will remain open until early March.



## Winter Conditions
