Perley Health Community of Care Expansion

Perley Health has taken a big step toward significantly increasing the number of people it serves. Earlier this month, Perley Health's Board of Directors approved the next step in the planning and design of a new on-site building that will provide long-term care for an additional 120 residents. Over the next few months, Perley Health will work through the required processes in preparation for provincial and municipal approvals. The current target date for occupancy is the end of 2028.

While we are moving through the next steps, Perley Health is engaging in open and transparent communication through a dedicated project website that includes a link to an online survey.

The survey will remain open until early March, and the feedback gathered will help guide the project's design and development.

The expansion project would help meet growing demand for long-term care. Across Ontario, more than 48,000 people are currently on wait lists for long-term care. Today, there are more than 1,000 people on the waitlist for long-term care at Perley

Health. In the Ottawa area, in the future, demand for long-term care is expected to increase by more than 43 percent.

Funding for the project will be secured through a combination of public and private sources. In August, the Government of Ontario introduced a new Construction Funding Program to facilitate access to capital for long-term care home expansions. In addition, philanthropic contributions will play a vital role in supporting the initiative.

Perley Health is a unique community of care that prioritizes Seniors and Veterans. Currently, more than 600 people live here: 450 in long-term care and another 150 in independent-living apartments. It also provides short-stay accommodations, along with a growing range of therapeutic and clinical programs and services to Seniors and Veterans. The Perley is also a centre for research, education, and clinical innovation. The on-site Centre of Excellence in Frailty-Informed Care™, established in 2019, conducts and shares the practical research to improve care for Seniors and Veterans.

The planned expansion is the latest example of the Perley's remarkable and ongoing evolution. In September, the Active

Seniors and Veterans Living Centre by Perley Health opened. The Centre provides a wide range of affordable, accessible programming—from fitness and recreation to mental wellness and peer connection—all tailored to support engaged, purposeful aging. In the new year, an on-site 49-space childcare centre, in partnership with Andrew Fleck Children's Services, is scheduled to open. The childcare centre will feature innovative intergenerational programming.
