Parking Rate Increase Effective January 1, 2026

Please be advised that effective January 1, 2026, parking rates will increase by 3% due to rising operational and maintenance costs. Our commitment is to provide a seamless experience for those picking up and dropping off passengers.

Vehicles on the property for 30 minutes or less will remain free of charge.
